# EPD – «Prospective EPDs»

## Definition and description of Prospective EPDs:

- Prospective EPDs are intended for products which either are; recently on the market or soon will enter the market.
- Prospective EPDs are intended for products where 12 months of production data is not available and therefore have higher uncertainty and limited comparability.
- The Prospective EPD shall not be valid for longer than one year and need to be reviewed after one year of production data is available.
- It shall be clearly identified in the EPD that it is a Prospective EPD and the variability and uncertainty of the limited set of data it is based upon.
- Prospective EPDs can only be created with explicit permission from EPD-Norway. It is important that the EPD user is aware of the main differences between the respective EPD types and uses EPDs accordingly.
- Prospective EPDs are “in accordance with ISO 14025 and based on EN 15804”.
- Prospective EPDs can be named P-EPDs
