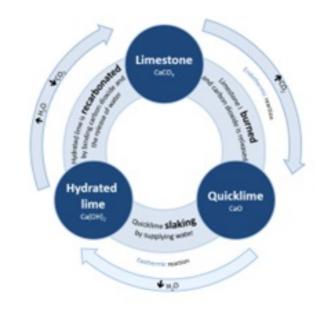

Product

Product description:

Quicklime, calcium oxide, CaO, is produced in high shaft kilns, rotating furnaces or in ring furnaces by heating limestone, CaCO3 (calcium carbonate), at approx. 1200°C: CaCO3 = CaO + CO2.

Quicklime can be used as a starting material for slaked quicklime Ca(OH)2 or hydrated lime or wet slaked lime. The final product can be used for various stabilization purposes such as stabilization (deep stabilization, mass stabilization, ground stabilization) lime paint, chemicals with exothermic properties (dewatering, hygienisation) etc. applications

Product specification

Approved according to the following standards: NS-EN 459 as CL 90-Q which consists of: CaO Calcium oxide >96%

CaCO3 Calcium carbonate < 3%

Technical data:

The product consists of >96% CaO + MgO, in bulk.

After the limestone (CaCO3) has been taken out of quarries or mines, it is crushed different fractions (furnace stone). The reactive line includes that furnace stone sinters in a shaft furnace, which can be crushed down and sieved (fractionation) and production of finely ground quicklime (mill process).

EPD applies to quicklime in various fractions. It has been prepared declarations of performance, CE documentation, product data sheets and safety data sheets. Technical data appears in that documentation. Quicklime can carbonate when exposed to air.

Cut-off criteria:

All major raw materials and all the essential energy is included. The production processes for raw materials and energy flows with very small amounts (less than 1%) are not included. These cut-off criteria do not apply for hazardous materials and substances.

Allocation:

The allocation is made in accordance with the provisions of EN 15804. Incoming energy and water and waste production in-house is allocated equally among all products through mass allocation. Effects of primary production of recycled materials is allocated to the main product in which the material was used. The recycling process and transportation of the material is allocated to this analysis.

Data quality:

Specific data for the product composition are provided by the manufacturer. The data represent the production of the declared product and were collected for EPD development in the year of study. Background data is based on EPDs according to EN 15804 and different LCA databases.

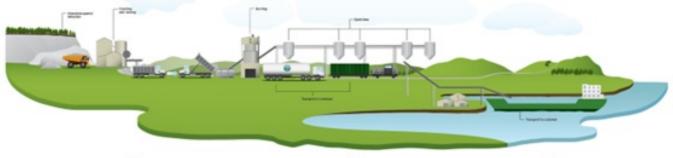


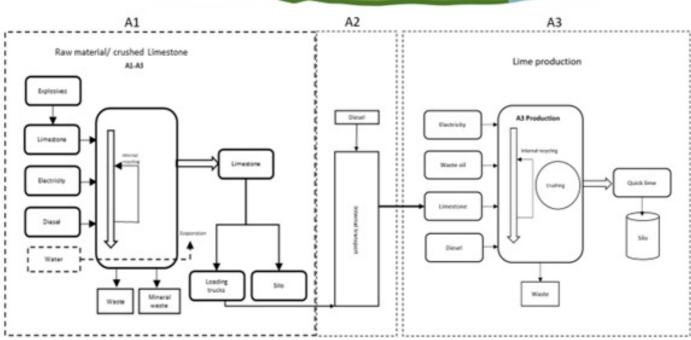
