Cut-off criteria:

All major raw materials and all the essential energy is included. The production processes for raw materials and energy flows with very small amounts (less than 1%) are not included. These cut-off criteria do not apply for hazardous materials and substances.

Allocation:

The allocation is made in accordance with the provisions of EN 15804. Incoming energy and water and waste production in-house is allocated equally among all products through mass allocation. Effects of primary production of recycled materials is allocated to the main product in which the material was used. The recycling process and transportation of the material is allocated to this analysis.


Data quality:



Concrete exposed to longtime contact with water and chlorides, e.g. swimming pools or industrial waters containing chlorides (XD2), concrete exposed to water splash containing chlorides or exposed to de-icing agents (XD3), concrete exposed to water splash from seawater (XS3), concrete exposed to water, freezing and chloride, e.g. road and bridge decks exposed to de-icing agents and splash zones of maine structures exposed to freezing (XF4), as well as concrete exposed to natural soil and ground water with a highly aggressive chemical environment (XA3).

Potential ionizing radiation from the soil, from radon and from some construction materials is also not measured by this indicator.
